Snowballing

Levels: All levels



Explanation: This strategy enables students to think about an object and begin a collaboration process where ideas are shared initially in pairs and then in larger groups.

Handling it:

- 1. A relevant question about the object is asked.
- 2. Individually students write down their ideas to answer the question.
- 3. Students pair up and compare answers.
- 4. Students move into groups of four and continue to compare and discuss.
- 5. Groups can continue to snowball as desired. As the groups get larger roles will need to be allocated such as spokesperson/facilitator, time keeper, scribe, task master, encourager, resource manager.
- 6. A final class discussion as groups report back their ideas.
