

- 2. **Piupiu** kākahu (clothing)
- 3. Kōhatu mauri- kohatu/kowhatu meaning stone or rock
- 4. **Kete** great for collecting pipi!
- 5. Matau- used for hī ika (fishing)
- 6. **Koruru** carved face on the gable of a wharenui, often representing the ancestor after which the house is named
- 7. **Tatā** used to bail out water from your waka
- 8. Kahu huruhuru- huruhuru means feathers
